OUR WORDS

Greetings All!

As you read this missive, we are probably still at Southern Crusades.

November 13th is our next A&S evening (6-8PM at Thorpe Adult Center). Thegn Gunnar has asked HE Eirny to teach Her "Researching on the Cheap" class. This is an excellent class for those who think that they would like to do some research, but really aren't sure how to start or where to look. It is also a great way to learn to navigate around the internet and acquire valuable and reliable, and CHEAP (or FREE) information without having to purchase a large number of expensive books.

We would really like to encourage everyone to take advantage of this class. Why? Well three main reasons. Number One - February will be Ered Sulabration. And Ered Sulabration is when we do our Baronial A&S Champion Competition. We know that there are plenty of folks in the Barony who make "stuff". You don't HAVE to have documentation for your entry, but two equally crafty entries and if one has even a smidgen of documentation - the one with the documentation wins. A&S Champion is the only Championship that you must be a member of Ered Sul to win. Why? Because We want the winner to help with A&S in the Barony. What does helping mean? Share your knowledge. How did you make what earned you the title? Anyone can enter the competition, and We always have a populace choice award, but the Champion HAS to be from Ered Sul.

The second reason for taking this class is a simple one - to learn something. If you learn a single piece of information, about any topic, that is useful or encourages you to do something cool or fun then everyone benefits.

And third - the class is in your own Barony! We know that the drive is too far for those of you in Payson, Pine, or Holbrook on a weeknight, but for many of you it is in your home town! Take advantage of the opportunity to take a class that Eirny usually only offers at Estrella, Gulf War, and Pennsic.

We constantly find that many of Our Southern neighbors have an attitude about those of us from the North: we are ignorant, we are not talented, and we don't DO anything except fight. Well, We think that they are wrong, but the reality is that if the North does not enter competitions and displays then no one knows what we can do. We have personally had less than wonderful experiences with some of the A&S judging in Atenveldt, but a serious effort is being made to change that. We will NOT allow one bad experience to keep Us from participating in an activity that We love. If you do not want to compete outside of your own barony, you do not have to, but please consider doing a display. They have already posted information on a display at Southern Crusades and there will be lots of other opportunities besides that.

We have been asked by Master Raven, the Kingdom Arts Minister, to share this information with Our populace. We think that this is an excellent opportunity to show the Kingdom what the

North can do. If you cannot attend and wish to participate, please contact Us and We will make arrangements for your items to be entered or displayed.

Machines: An apparatus consisting of interrelated parts with separate functions, used in the performance of some kind of work. A machine documented to pre 17th Century Western Europe that is fully functioning, stand alone and does not need additional items for assistance. Entries may be of any working scale and will need to be demonstrated at the Competition; detailed diagrams and list of parts will need to be included in Documentation. Time needed to demonstrate will need to be included in pre-registration description.

Pickling/Preserving: An item of food available in pre-17th century Western Europe that has been pickled or preserved through the process of fermenting used in the same time frame. The food and the pickling/preserving process will need to be kept within the same time frame and regional area for each entry. All entries will include a list of ingredients and presented in a ready to be sampled format.

Working Class Clothing: Clothing worn on a daily basis as a means of earning one's livelihood, including a minimum of 3 pieces of clothing that would be worn simultaneously by a person of the lower classes of pre 17th Century Western Europe. Layers should be worn together as an ensemble, not including headwear/footwear or accompanying accessories. Documentation should also include a brief description of the types of work that could have been performed in this outfit.

There are already discussions about adding new opportunities to display arts and crafts at Estrella. We will make an effort to make sure that any new information that We receive is passed on to the Barony.

Our first Combined Indoor Practice will happen Sunday November 18th at the Flagstaff National Guard Armory. Indoor practice is always a fun event with something for everyone. Come fight, do an art/science, dance, or just hang out. Please read the event notice in this Higher Word for more details and other dates. HE Eirny is planning to offer specific A&S classes at every combined practice that We can attend.

Northern Yule is just around the corner! As many of you know, Ered Sul, Granite Mountain, and Windale take turns hosting the Northern Yule celebration. This year our Yule will be held in the Shire of Windale on December 8.th Join Us, and Our friends from the North at Northern Yule.

The weekend following our Yule, We plan to attend the Barony of Starkhavn Yule to continue our good relations with this very close neighbor from Caid. For those who do not know, we are closer in time and distance to Starkhavn than they are to any of their own kingdom's events.

We have a new Captain of Archery, Ivar of Elsinore (Don Fisher). It is Our intention to find a way for archery to occur as often as possible during the winter months.

His Lordship Gil Gareth Greywolf will step down as Our Baronial Seneschal on November 20th, after a tenure that held many Society level challenges for him and Us. We have accepted a letter of intent from m'Lady Liadan of Laithland (Mindy Fisher) as Our new Seneschal. Lord Chavez remains Deputy Seneschal (SCA Household and work responsibilities precluded him from accepting the Seneschal position). Having more than one person who understands the duties of the Seneschal and can "cover" in the absence of the Seneschal is a good thing, and we are open to adding more deputies.

Estrella has been moved earlier in the year to avoid the "bake-a-thon" we had last year. It may be colder, but we can always put on more layers. When you're down to your skin, like last year, there's not much left to do to stay cool! The mains for Estrella are working hard to improve all of our experience at Atenveldt's War. A number of land changes are being made: merchants will be moved onto grass, camping areas expanded, water spigots installed in new camping areas, and much more. Along with the land changes, the Barons and Baronesses of Atenveldt are taking responsibility for land allocation for camping. We MUST have Our numbers for the Barony and all allied Households who will camp with Us complete by December 7th. AND We need your numbers by December 5th. If you will NOT camp with a household, send your camping intentions to coronet@baronyoferedsul.org. If you are camping with a household, give them your names and numbers of campers. Although pre-registration is important to Estrella management, you DO NOT have to pre-register to give us your intent to camp with Ered Sul.

WE WILL ALLOCATE LAND ACCORDING TO WHO SAYS THEY WILL CAMP WITH US. IF YOU DO NOT IDENTIFY THAT YOU WILL BE CAMPING WITH ERED SUL, WE MAY RUN OUT OF ROOM FOR YOU TO CAMP WITH US.

At Coronation, HRM Tristan announced that all Aten fighters should be clothed in Blue and Yellow tabards etc. for the war. We are checking the Barony's stash of tabards to see what we have. His Majesty envisions a sea of blue and yellow on the field as in days gone by.

Once again We will be traveling to Gulf War with HE Eirny's business. In keeping with Our philosophy of "things" continuing even if We aren't there, We will **not** be at Combined Practice in March, the event goes on in Our absence.

Highlands War is making its relentless advance towards us. There's a lot to do. Please volunteer in any capacity to help the Ladies Violet and Dubhchobhlaigh with planning and executing this war. We have a preliminary layout of the site with camping, battlefields, archery, siege weapons, Arts & Science, and an equestrian arena. We are working on getting storage near to the site (or perhaps on the site) for Highlands-only things. We will pre-position current Highlands-only things in storage at the event site before the event.

We have also tested a new piece of equipment on-site to provide Our merchants with credit card machine communications, and limited cell phone access within the merchant area. We tested the equipment using three simultaneous cellular connections with success. The test setup was not

ideal for the system, but we know that we'll be able to provide necessary communications for Our merchants and limited cell phone service in the merchant area.

It's a new Reign and new opportunities to submit people for award recommendations. Please make your awards recommendations to Us and to the Crown.

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Baronial Officers –

Last year We told those assembled at several meetings/events that We will be publishing office want ads where the current office holder's warrant is due to expire. It is Our policy to accept an officer's extension for one year beyond the current expiration of their warrant. We want to broaden our office corps including Deputies and Greater and Lesser Officer.

Thegn Gunnar, Our current A&S Champion, has graciously accepted the position of Interim A&S Officer. He has agreed to serve for a year as A&S Officer, but to make everything conform to Kingdom regulations, the position was advertised and is now filled by Thegn Gunnar. We would like to find at least two A&S Deputies to help lighten the load for all involved and make it easier to cover various events.

Barony of Ered Sûl Herald – Lady Lora of the Four Paws (Laura Minas) is our current baronial herald with a warrant that expires in July of 2014. Having more than one person who understands the duties of the herald and can “cover” in the absence of the main herald is a good thing. We would like to find her at least one or two official deputies.

Requirements: The Deputy Herald Position is divided into three areas of responsibility, the same as the regular Herald – voice heraldry, court recording, and helping baronial members with heraldic and name submissions.

Voice Heraldry requires that the Herald is capable of starting, running and concluding a baronial court, and working with other baronial and kingdom heralds. The herald must keep track of the activities that are to occur during the court, control the distribution of scrolls and award medallions, and generally assist with the flow of court. The herald should be able to travel to distant events at least some of the time.

Court Recording means that the herald is must report the awards that are given in court to the Kingdom heralds so that the Kingdom OP may be kept current. The Herald needs to also periodically review the Kingdom OP to make sure that Kingdom is entering the award information correctly.

Heraldic and Name Submissions are an important part of the Herald's duty. The populace needs assistance in negotiating the rules for name and research and submission.

To apply for any Deputy position, you must send a letter of intent to the Baron and Baroness. This letter must include your name, membership number, SCA experience, and contact information. In addition, if you are applying for the first time, We would like to hear your ideas for classes and workshops and your goals for this office. If you are currently holding this office we would like an honest assessment of what sort of a job you feel you have been doing in this position, how you feel you can improve your performance, and your plans for the future.

Let all Princes, Barons, Thegns, Knights, Masters, Squires, Lords, Lady Combatants and Men-at-Arms of the Kingdom of Atenveldt, and all other Known World Kingdoms, who are not banished or enemies of our Glorious Aten Thrones, know that on Sunday, the 16th Day of December in the Year of the Society, Forty Seven, known as Two Thousand Twelve in the Common Reckoning, at Himmel Park, within the boundaries of the Barony of Tir Ysgithr:

There will be a very great Passage of Arms called THE HUNT whereupon all challengers (Venans) shall hunt noble prey from among them (Tenans). Those who intend to fight in the lists must acquire a free invitation from the Baron and Baroness of Tir Ysgithr or must request the ability to fight from among the Seven Knightly Virtues Incarnate, represented as Courage, Loyalty, Courtesy, Honor, Franchise, Prowess and Faith. These ladies will provide quests of various degrees for our noble challengers to fulfill and shall be on the lookout for examples from among the challengers of the virtues they hold dear. All shall be conducted with good camaraderie and with good cheer.

There will be fighting opportunities for all armored combatants, fencing combatants and youth combatants. Fighters need not have a specific kit, but are encouraged to dress in their best fighting armor appropriate to their own persona style. The display of pageantry is highly encouraged with banners, colors and the like.

We will have a consort’s gallery for all those consorts to witness the honorable combat upon the field.

We will have snack foods provided for sale by the College of St. Felix to include meat pies, vegetable pies, non-alcoholic beverages and possibly smoked turkey legs for a reasonable fee.

Site fee will be \$3.00 per adult; \$1.00 per child 8-17 years old. The non-member surcharge will apply.
