The baronial A&S officer organizes workshops on a variety of topics for the members of the populace. They may even participate in the Kingdom A&S Collegium and/or Competition. They will certainly encourage you to do so as well!

A well prepared A&S Minister has a deputy who can assist in the division of labor and step into the role temporarily if the position becomes unexpectedly open while the advertising period for a new A&S Minister lasts. Northern Atenveldt Combined Fighter Practice

Sunday June 15 from noon – 5pm at the Juniper Woods Land Owners Association Clubhouse in Ash Fork, AZ.

This event is for outdoor archery, hard suit, rapier fighters and indoor A&S workshops.

Directions to the site: From I40 take 89 south for 2.1 miles. Turn right on Bullock Drive. THIS IS OPEN RANGE. As soon as you cross the cattle guard onto the road it is your job not to hit a cow. Follow the pavement until it ends at the RR track. Then follow the dirt road as it curves to the left in front of the church and go 1.5 miles. Folkerts Lane will be on your left, and the building on the left side is the clubhouse. There will be a sign. Park in the parking lot.

This is a dry site, pop-ups are allowed but secure them well in the wind. Smoking outdoors is permitted with a butt can, but the county has a fire ban in place already.

There will be additional combined fighter practices at this location on Sunday September 28.

Directions: From the south, take I-17 north to Willard Springs (Exit 326). From the north, take

I-17 south to Willard Springs (Exit 326). Follow the paved road, bearing right past the refuse transfer station approximately 1/2 mile to Blowout Tank meadow (on the right). There will be SCA signs.
