Greetings All!

It seems like we just ended the busy season for the Barony of Ered Sûl, yet here it comes again!

January 13th is our next indoor combined practice. It's a lot of fun and runs from 1PM to 5PM at the Flagstaff National Guard Armory on Thorpe Rd. Are you a fighter (hardsuit, rapier, or youth)? INDOOR practice can't be beat with our current weather! A dancer? Come on down, we'll dance! Have a project to work on? Want some help? Have a question? There's help available. HE Eirny will be continuing her garb festivities! Help will be available for patterning new garb, repairing and refitting old. Bring your garb, your machine, or whatever and be ready to look spiffy!

There will be 2 war practices before Estrella. The first one will be January 20th after Saturday's Heros of the Silent Angels in Atenveldt. Saturday February 2nd will see a war practice in Granite Mountain. We are planning to attend this war practice. Car pooling can be a fun way to spend more time with friends.

February 10th is Ered Sulabration! It will be held at the Flagstaff National; Guard Armory. Look for the event announcement in this newsletter. Ered Sulabration is when we do our Baronial A&S Champion Competition. We know that there are plenty of folks in the Barony who make "stuff". You don't HAVE to have documentation for your entry, but two equally crafty entries and if one has even a smidgen of documentation - the one with the documentation wins. A&S Champion is the only Championship that you must be a member of Ered Sûl to win. We want the winner to help with A&S in the Barony. What does helping mean? Share your knowledge. How did you make what earned you the title? Anyone can enter the competition, and We always have a populace choice award, but the Champion HAS to be from Ered Sûl.

We constantly find that many of Our Southern neighbors have an attitude about those of us from the North: we are ignorant, we are not talented, and we don't DO anything except fight. Well, We think that they are wrong, but the reality is that if the North does not enter competitions and displays then no one knows what we can do. If you do not want to compete outside of your own barony, you do not have to, but please consider doing a display. There will be opportunities to display arts and crafts at Estrella and many other upcoming events. We will make an effort to make sure that any new information that We receive is passed on to the Barony.

Don't forget that We have a new Captain of Archery, Ivar of Elsinore (Don Fisher). It is Our intention to find a way for archery to occur as often as possible during the winter months. Please offer to help Ivar with archery to help get the program running!

M'Lady Liadan of Laithland (Mindy Fisher) is Our new Seneschal. Lord Chavez remains Deputy Seneschal (SCA Household and work responsibilities precluded him from accepting the Seneschal position). Having more than one person who understands the duties of the Seneschal and can "cover" in the absence of the Seneschal is a good thing, and we are open to adding more deputies.

Estrella has been moved earlier in the year to avoid the “bake-a-thon” we had last year. It may be colder, but we can always put on more layers. When you’re down to your skin, like last year, there’s not much left to do to stay cool! The mains for Estrella are working hard to improve all of our experience at Atenveldt’s war. A number of land changes are being made: merchants will be moved onto grass, camping areas expanded, water spigots installed in new camping areas, and much more. Along with the land changes, the Barons and Baronesses of Atenveldt are taking responsibility for land allocation for camping. We have been allocated Our land for Estrella – enough to hold the 303 people who responded to Our call for names for Estrella campers. Each camper has been allocated 250 square feet of space. Please remember that you must allow for walkways and common areas. Sharing common areas is a great way to get to know other folks! We have pre-registered for Estrella! Have you?

At Coronation, HRM Tristan announced that all Aten fighters should be clothed in Blue and Yellow tabards etc. for the war. His Majesty envisions a sea of blue and yellow on the field as in days gone by – which we can support with tabards. If you don’t have one, please see Us at January’s indoor practice. We have passed them out at the last TWO practices.

Once again We will be traveling to Gulf War with HE Eirny’s business. In keeping with Our philosophy of “things” continuing even if We aren’t there, We will **not** be at Combined Practice in March, the event goes on in Our absence.

Highlands War is relentlessly advancing towards us – but your War Staff and the property owners have been making tremendous progress. Have you looked at the new Highlands War Website: <http://highlandswar.org/>

There’s a lot to do. Please volunteer in any capacity to help the Ladies Violet and Dubhchobhlaigh with planning and executing this war. Mistress Grainne has agreed to be Our Scheduling Officer for Highlands this year. She will be recruiting teachers and setting up the schedule of A&S Classes.

We have a preliminary layout of the site with camping, battlefields, archery, siege weapons, Arts & Science, and an equestrian arena. We have storage near to the site in Alpine for Highlands-only things. HE has already made a full-box truck trip from Flagstaff to Alpine to pre-position current Highlands-only things in storage. A special Thank You to: Jake Highline, Janquith, and Sir Sterling who came out to help load the truck in Flagstaff.

It’s a new Reign and new opportunities to submit people for award recommendations. Please make your awards recommendations to Us and to the Crown. Oh, and by the way...if you don’t show up to events you will NOT get awards. We can’t hand out scrolls to people who don’t show up!

Baronial Officers –

Last year We told those assembled at several meetings/events that We will be publishing office want ads where the current office holder's warrant is due to expire. It is Our policy to accept an officer's extension for one year beyond the current expiration of their warrant. We want to broaden our office corps including Deputies and Greater and Lesser Officer.

Barony of Ered Sûl A&S - Thegn Gunnar, Our current A&S Champion, agreed to serve for a year as A&S Officer. He will be stepping down after Highlands. We would like people to consider whether they could take this position when it comes open. We would also like to find at least two A&S Deputies to help lighten the load for all involved and make it easier to cover various events.

Barony of Ered Sûl Herald – Lady Lora of the Four Paws (Laura Minas) is our current baronial herald with a warrant that expires in July of 2014. Having more than one person who understands the duties of the herald and can “cover” in the absence of the main herald is a good thing. We would like to find her at least one or two official deputies.

Requirements: The Deputy Herald Position is divided into three areas of responsibility, the same as the regular Herald – voice heraldry, court recording, and helping baronial members with heraldic and name submissions.

Voice Heraldry requires that the Herald is capable of starting, running and concluding a baronial court, and working with other baronial and kingdom heralds. The herald must keep track of the activities that are to occur during the court, control the distribution of scrolls and award medallions, and generally assist with the flow of court. The herald should be able to travel to distant events at least some of the time.

Court Recording means that the herald is must report the awards that are given in court to the Kingdom heralds so that the Kingdom OP may be kept current. The Herald needs to also periodically review the Kingdom OP to make sure that Kingdom is entering the award information correctly.

Heraldic and Name Submissions are an important part of the Herald's duty. The populace needs assistance in negotiating the rules for name and research and submission.

To apply for any Deputy position, you must send a letter of intent to the Baron and Baroness. This letter must include your name, membership number, SCA experience, and contact information. In addition, if you are applying for the first time, We would like to hear your ideas for classes and workshops and your goals for this office. If you are currently holding this office we would like an honest assessment of what sort of a job you feel you have been doing in this position, how you feel you can improve your performance, and your plans for the future.

The History of Eréd Sûl

For all of you who were present July of AS 46 (2011) at Too Darn Hot, and attended Our First Court, you may remember that We created a new honor for a member of Eréd Sûl – the Office of Baronial Historian. The recipient of this honor was Baron Master Roger von Allenstein. Baron Roger has proved to be a HUGE help to Us in searching out the traditions of Eréd Sûl, since We Ourselves have only lived in the barony for about seven years. At Too Darn Hot AS 47 (also known as Too Darn Wet!) Roger officially received his Blue Linen Hood, as a sign of his office.

Baron Roger is the Keeper of the Newsletters – he owns a complete set of every newsletter ever published in Eréd Sûl, and taking his job seriously, he has begun to provide us with tidbits about the history of the Barony, which we intend to include in Our monthly newsletter for the edification of the Populace. The actual dates that are included with the names of the individuals are based on the information in the newsletters, which as we all know, may not be totally accurate, BUT they do give us a sense of timeframe.

This event will be FREE and filled with tournaments and prizes for all to participate in. If you have someone you want to bring out to introduce them to the SCA, this event is one that will enamor them with the “stardust”. There will be a youth corner with crafts & games to entertain your young ones. A&S competitions and displays with an area to work on your projects. Please join us for a Spaghetti dinner provided by Countess Mary Rose on Saturday night that will be accompanied by entertainment provided by Patrick the Butcher.

Merchants are welcome; we just ask that they contact an autocrat for details.

Archery tournaments will be held on January 6th at 9 am at the Barony of Atenveldt/Sundragon's practice site.

Saturday will be for the Heroes, who put their armor on to help support this special group known as Silent Angels. There will be Rapier and Hard Suit prize tournaments to raise donations for the International Rett Syndrome Foundation. A small donation would be greatly appreciated but is not required to enter the tournaments. The Hard Suit and Rapier List will open at 9:30am & close at 10:30am. The Helm Auction will begin following court and fighting will begin after auction is concluded.

Artisans and masters from all over the kingdom have in the past donated amazing and beautiful works of artistry, to the silent auction. We are excited to receive their donations again this year. This is a magnificent opportunity to own amazing pieces of handcrafted art as well as the occasional random or amazing bits of Atenveldt history.

For those who may not have heard of Rett Syndrome here is a brief description of this syndrome and how it affects these Angels.

Rett Syndrome is a severe neurological disorder that primarily affects girls. Rett Syndrome is the most physically disabling of the autism spectrum disorders. Rett Syndrome is caused by a mutation in the gene MECP2 –a protein that regulates the expression of other genes by turning them off at the appropriate time. The mutation is spontaneous and the effects are seen in early childhood between 6 to 18 months of age. The disorder destroys speech, movement, and

functional hand use. Many children lose the ability to walk, they struggle daily with severe seizures, scoliosis, breathing abnormalities, and often the child becomes dependent on others for a lifetime of care. These children's normal life expectancy is to the age of 14 to 17.


